FILIPINO AMERICAN HISTORY MONTH Celebrations

Chicago, II. – The US Congress officially passed laws to recognize October 2010 and every October thereafter as Filipino American History Month (FAHM) to celebrate the history and culture of Filipino Americans and their historic contributions to the Nation. For the 4th year in a row, the Filipino American community in Chicago and suburbs has been organizing programs and events to celebrate the FAHM. This year, the celebrations were plentiful throughout the month from film showings, cultural, theater, music and arts programs, banquets honoring Filipino American hall of famers and outstanding seniors, fashion shows, performances by celebrities Martin Nievera and 4 comedians from the Philippines, guest speaker Prof. Mark Rice and a transformation of an alley in downtown Chicago to the streets of Manila.

In a proclamation dated August 22, 2014, "Pat Quinn, Governor of the State of Illinois do hereby proclaim October 2014 as FILIPINO AMERICAN HISTORY MONTH in Illinois in recognition of the contributions of Filipino Americans made in our state and to our nation as a whole and in celebration of all Filipinos who call Illinois home". Chicago Mayor Rahm Emanuel "encourages all Chicagoans to acknowledge the enduring legacy and ongoing impact of the Filipino American community, and join with them in celebrating this auspicious month". Like in the previous year, Skokie Mayor George Van Dusen, Darien Mayor Kathleen Moser Weaver, Glendale Heights Village President Linda Jackson and Mayor Roger Claar of Bolingbrook join in proclaiming October 2014 as FILIPINO AMERICAN HISTORY MONTH in their respective cities/villages. New this year, Addison Mayor Rich Veenstra and Bloomingdale Mayor Franco Coladipietro also joined in proclaiming FAHM in the village of Addison and Bloomingdale.

We hope that you find the events celebrating FAHM entertaining and educational. We hope to do it again next year and every October thereafter.
